

Urgent COVID-19 (coronavirus) update

As of 11pm last night (Sunday 3/15/20) the California Dental Association (CDA), in step with Gov. Newsom's recent Declaration of a State of Emergency, issued guidelines strongly recommending all dentists in California voluntarily suspend non-essential or non-urgent dental care for the next 14 days.

We are currently implementing these guidelines. If you have an appointment scheduled for the coming 2 weeks you will be receiving a call from us to reschedule. But please do feel free to call us in the meantime should you have any questions.

As always, and as recommended by the CDA, we will continue to be available as needed for emergency care and services. A true dental emergency includes trauma, pain or infection. We are striving to have our office staff be available by phone Monday to Friday from 9am to 2pm and our clinical staff and dentists available from 10am-1pm to treat the dental emergencies.

Our hearts go out to those who have been impacted by this COVID-19 global pandemic. We are grateful to the healthcare workers, local communities and governments around the world who are working to contain this Coronavirus. I assure you we understand the gravity of this pandemic and will take every precautionary measure possible.
